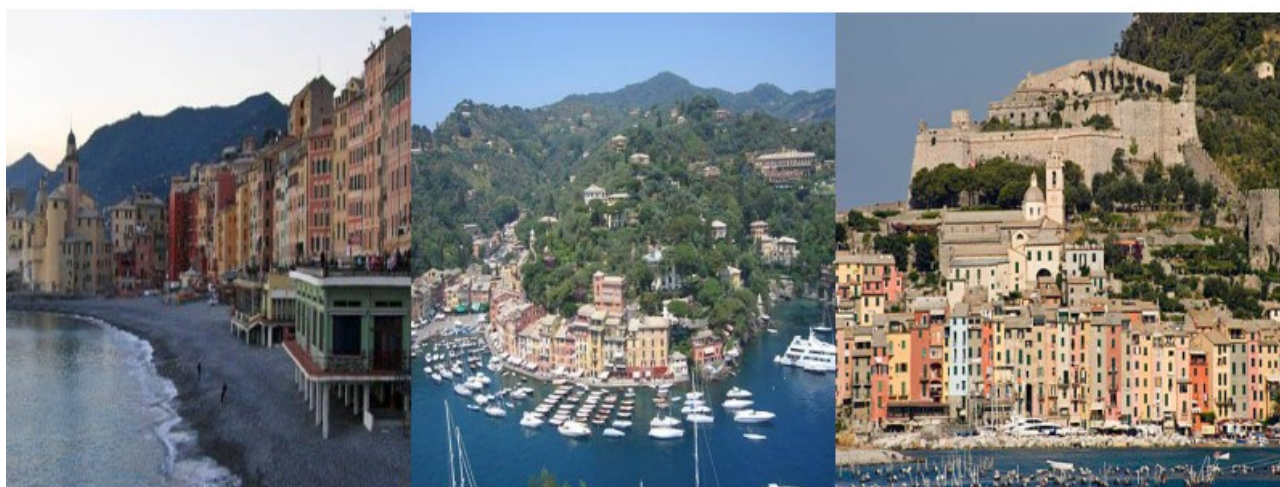


The MNE2010 is glad to invite you to discover the wonderful city of Genoa and its nearby!



You can discover the glamour of the old city:

- Let yourself get lost along the thick "caruggi" (little lanes) of the widest **MEDIEVAL HISTORICAL CENTRE** in Europe, looking for its manifold curiosities, its various mysteries and secrets. Admire its architectural beauties, represented by the *Palazzi Rolli*, included in the World Heritage List of UNESCO, *Via Garibaldi* and its museums, the early 13th-century *San Lorenzo Cathedral*, *Columbus' house* and in the old port area *San Giorgio*, the first bank in Italy.
- Discover the beautiful and modern **PORT AREA**: get on the "Bigo" and have a look of Genoa from the sky, visit the famous Renzo Piano's "bolla" and the *aquarium*, built for the EXPO 92 and the second largest in Europe.
- Visit our **MUSEUMS**: The National Gallery in the *Palazzo Spinola*, with original furnishings from the 16th-18th centuries, frescoed ceilings, and an excellent collection of art; the Civic Museum, housed in the 16th-century *Palazzo Bianco*, with a great collection of paintings by Genoese and other European artists; *Galata Museo del Mare*, the largest sea museum in the mediterranean which offers you a real tour in the old submarine "Nazario Sauro".



If you love the seaside you can discover the magic of the Italian Riviera:

- **Camogli** features a small harbor, with colorful houses built right up to the fine beach.
- **Portofino** is a beautiful village of pastel colored houses surrounding a half-moon harbor

- **Cinque Terre and Portovenere**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, a beautiful village with brightly colored houses lining the harbor and narrow medieval streets leading up the hill to its castle.
